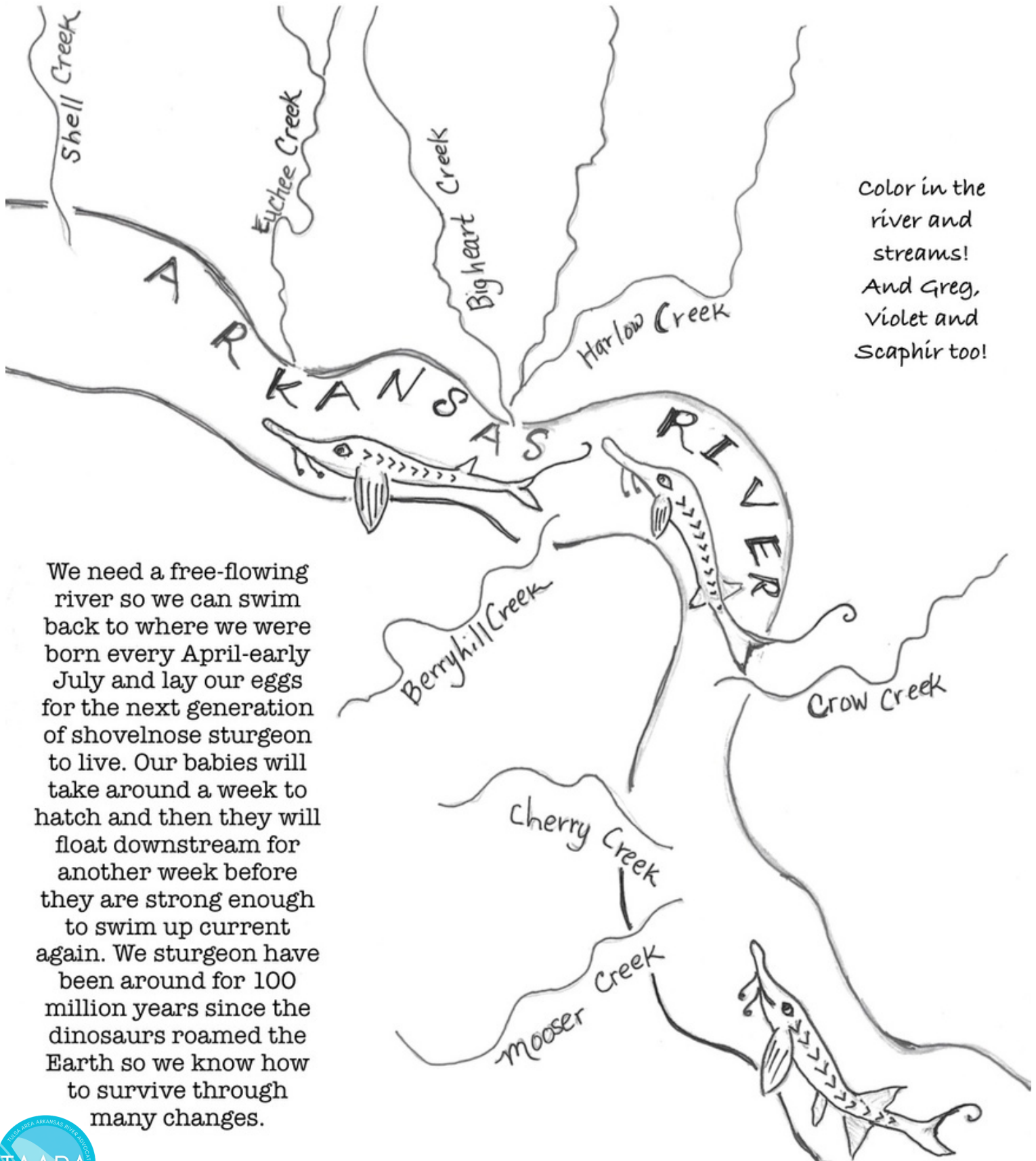


A Free-Flowing River
